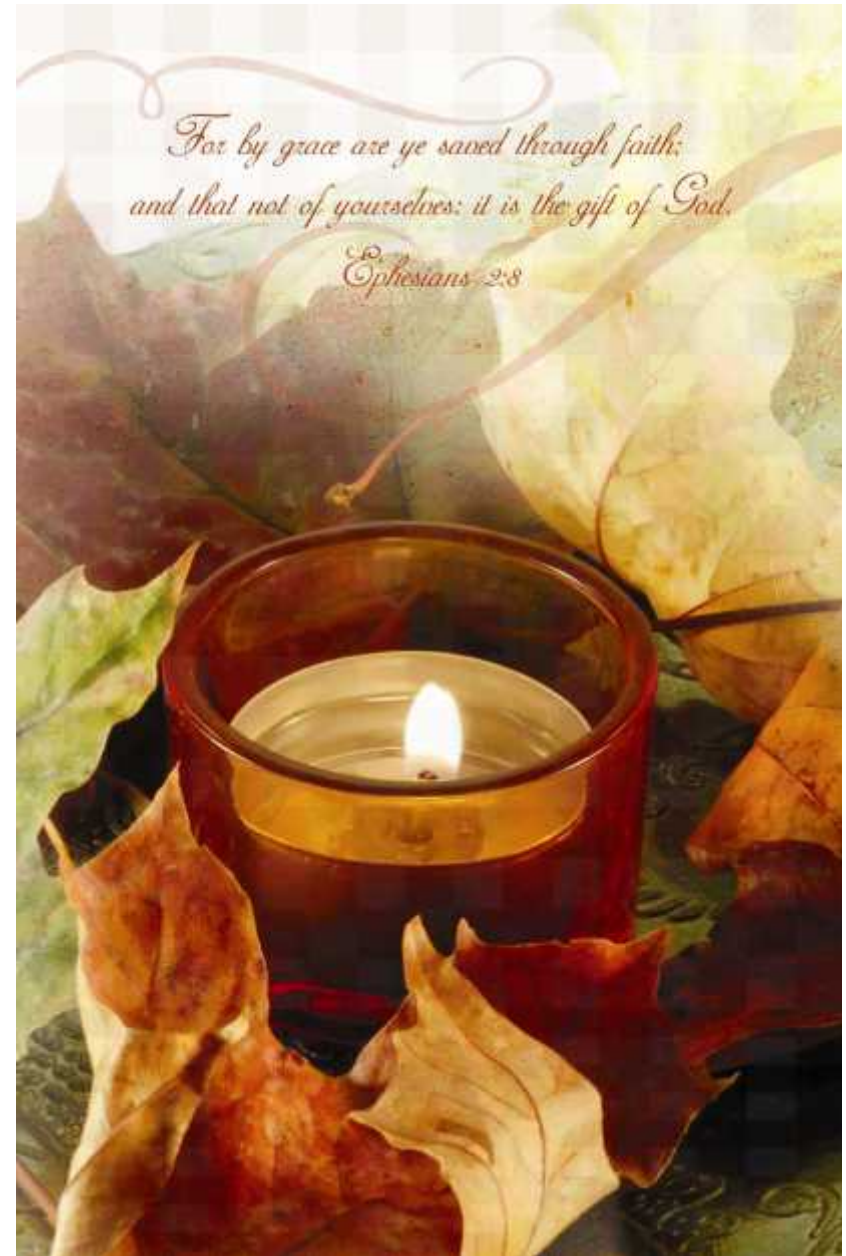

**Experiencing Grace**

*"And if by grace, then it is no longer by works; if it were, grace would no longer be grace." – Romans 11:6*

James Berry was born in 1852 in Yorkshire, England. He served eight years with the Bradford Police Force, then tried himself as a boot salesman. Since he did not earn enough for the upkeep of his family, he applied for the job of public executioner.

From 1884 to 1892, he executed 134 men and women. The weight of his profession took its toll on him. James became a heavy drinker and was constantly irritable. At aged 52, he resigned from his position and he decided to commit suicide by throwing himself off a train. James was sitting at the railroad station, when a young man walked up to him and started to talk to him. He invited James to the mission hall. For two and a half hours he heard about the grace of Jesus Christ and he gave his life to the Lord.

For the remaining 21 years of his life, James Berry was an evangelist, letting others know about the grace of God.

Grace is the unmerited favor of God. We did not earn it. We don't deserve it. We can just receive it as the loving gift from the God who will judge all mankind. Today in prayer, praise Christ for His gift of grace.

"Grace is what God gives us when we don't deserve and mercy is when God doesn't give us what we do deserve" – Reinhold Niebuhr
