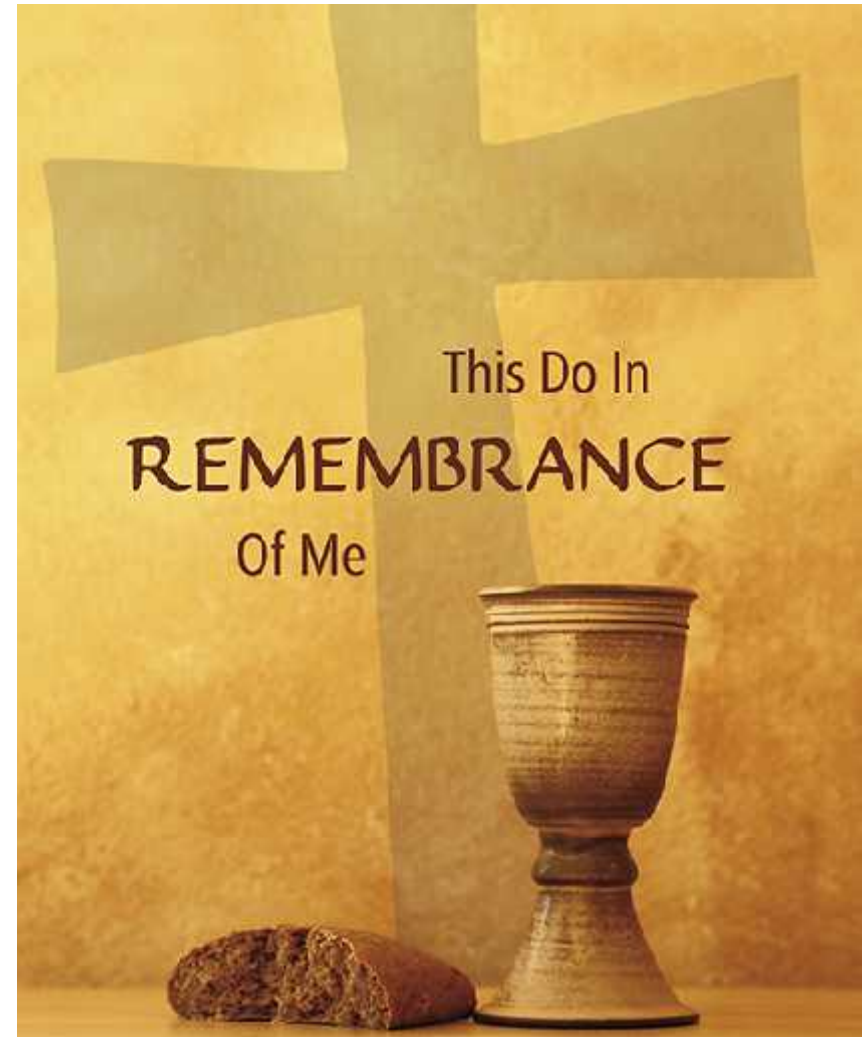

Devotional - Encourage One Another

"Each of us should please his neighbor for his good, to build him up." – Romans 15:2

In 2010, Lee Wright traveled to Chico, California. He had been homeless for 13 years and he found himself at the Jesus Center -- a local organization that provides meals and other types of assistance to the homeless. It soon became apparent that Lee had a talent, he could paint. The staff encouraged him by providing him with supplies and a place to paint during the day. At night, Lee would sleep behind a building wedged between his painting and garbage bins. But when a volunteer at the center saw his work, she was able to help him secure a commission for a painting. From there, more commissions followed and Lee has since been able to make enough money to rent his own apartment on a month-to-month basis. "Nothing of this would have happened without God," said Lee. He explained that to him the success of his portraits was like him asking for help and, "God said, 'You can get that.' Then He made it happen." "I was painting out of necessity. Now I'm painting out of thankfulness," said Lee.
